1-1. How to Sign-in

- When you access the Entra ID(Azure AD) application, you can sign in automatically without entering your account and password because of Microsoft Entra seamless single sign-on.

- If you want to enter your account and password in sign-in screen, please use the InPrivate Mode of browser.

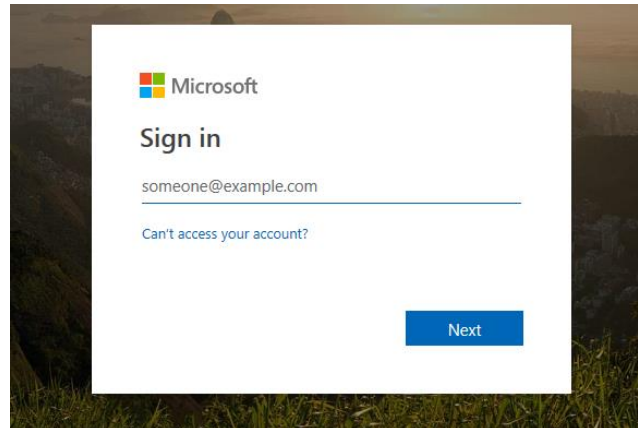


Figure 1-1-1: Sign-in screen

- Please choose a company based on your position when you use the application.

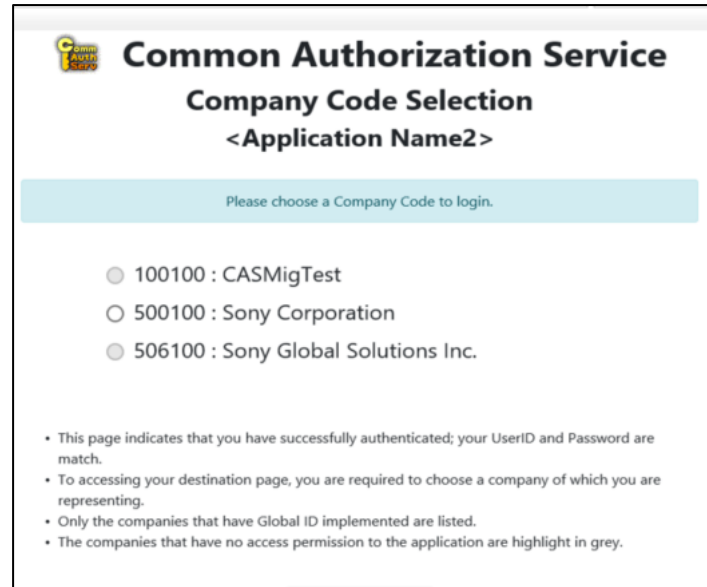


Figure 1-2-1: Company Selection Screen

- If you select the entire [someone@example.com](#) and try to overwrite or replace it, it may not work.

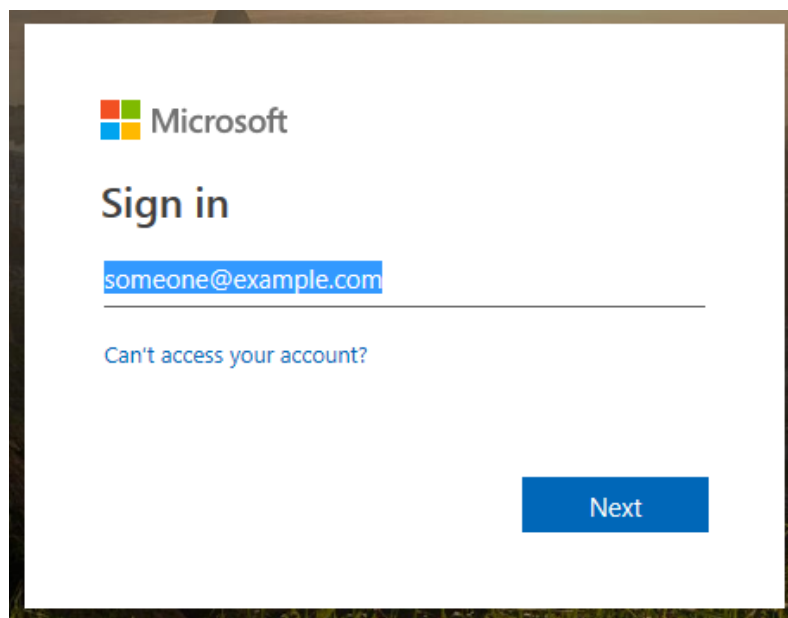
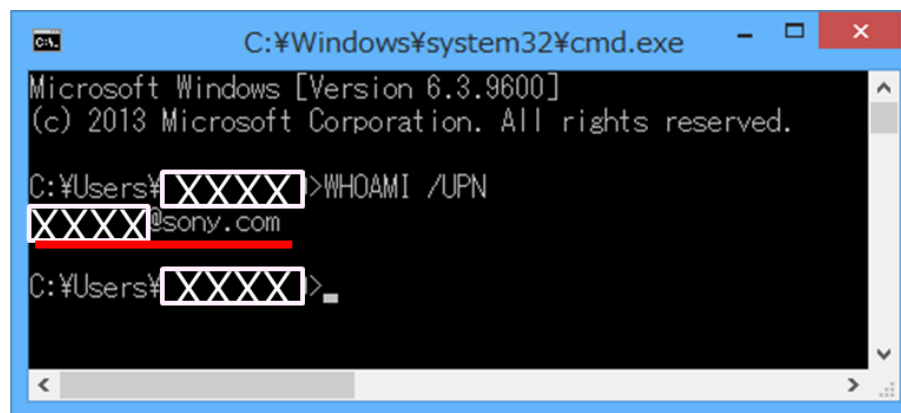


Figure Appendix-A-1: someone@example.com

Appendix B. How to verify account

- If you are using AD in Sony, after launching the command prompt, enter the following command to confirm the account displayed.
 - How to start the command prompt
 - Press the Windows and R buttons at the same time
 - Type "cmd" and click "OK" in the "Open(O)" window.
 - How to run a command
 - Input "whoami /upn" and press ENTER.
